Participants

The Summer School targets outstanding graduate economists. Priority will be given to local and regional students enrolled in Post graduate programs in economics.

Interested students should apply by submitting a short CV (2 pages maximum), a transcript, and a letter of recommendation via the RIDGE website: https://ridge.org.uy/summer_school/

The Scientific Committee, following standard criteria, will make the selection according to: GPA, publications and awards, a letter of recommendation and work experience.

The deadline for applying is January 31, 2026

The notification of the Scientific Committee decision will be sent by mid-February 2026

Only selected students will participate.
