Call for papers for the Workshop *Towards Sustainable Growth: From Micro to Macro Development*

The Research Institute for Development, Growth and Economics (RIDGE) is pleased to announce the call for papers for the workshop “Towards Sustainable Growth: From Micro to Macro Development.” We are relaunching the former “Towards Sustainable Growth” workshop with a renewed thematic and methodological focus under its new title. This edition focuses on research that explores how micro-level behaviors, frictions, and outcomes shape broader macroeconomic development. We particularly welcome contributions that combine reduced-form empirical strategies with structural approaches, and address topics such as:

- Firms, frictions, and spillovers
- Industrial policy
- Agricultural productivity and sectoral gaps
- Trade and spatial frictions
- Structural transformation

By bridging microeconomic evidence with macroeconomic implications, the workshop seeks to advance our understanding of the fundamental drivers of sustainable growth and the policies that can effectively foster development.
